Titans Hire TSU Alum Brett Maxie as Secondary Coach

The Tennessee Titans have hired TSU Alum Brett Maxie to be the team's secondary coach.

Maxie has spent the past four seasons with the Dallas Cowboys coaching defensive backs and has 14 seasons of NFL coaching experience, including stops at Miami, Atlanta, San Francisco and Carolina.

As an undrafted safety out of Texas Southern, he signed with New Orleans in 1985 and went on to have a 13-year NFL career. He played in 153 games, including 104 starts, recorded 23 interceptions and three touchdowns.

The team announced Maxie's hiring on Monday. He replaces Marcus Robertson, who was not retained at the end of the season. Titans coach Mike Munchak says Maxie's diverse experience as a player and a coach stood out to him.

Darrell Asberry was named head coach of the Texas Southern Tigers football team in December 2011 by athletics director Dr. Charles McClelland. Asberry was the head coach at Shaw University in Raleigh, North Carolina for the past five seasons.

As head coach, Asberry had a 40-25 overall record and a 30-13 conference record at Shaw. He captured three CIAA Championships in five seasons (2007, 2008 & 2010).

His teams ranked at the top in the nation both offensively and defensively. He also boasts an impressive graduation rate for his players.
